- 3. All contracts and documents referenced below may be subject to review by the Office of General Counsel and must comply with all University and Board policies governing the review, approval and execution of contracts.
- 4. Any one authorized signatory is sufficient for proper execution unless otherwise stated in this document or elsewhere.
